- Engage the best available experts to support the EU, Member States, and Associated Countries and their negotiators in processes of the Convention on Biological Diversity;

- Contribute to the development of monitoring and review process to support the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal GBF.

 - c. Detection and identification of living modified organisms. (item 7)
- C. Marine and coastal biodiversity, and in particular Conservation and sustainable use (item 8b)
- D. Biodiversity and health. (item 9)

This training session will take stock of the SBSTTA 26 agenda, history, context, and look at some of the challenges of the topics above in the context of the CBD. It will target an audience of thematic experts who are not necessarily familiar with the CBD process but would like to learn more about it.
